Science Spot

Active science in Year 3: As part of their Roots and shoots topic, Mrs Macmillan's class have been using actions to help them remember different ways that seeds are dispersed. Seeds have adapted to leave the parent plant to find a their own space to grow by either water (floating away in a body of water) explosion (where seed pods explode when they are ripe enough) drop and roll (where they simply fall to the ground and roll away) by being eaten by birds or animals (where they pass through the animal's digestive system) and wind (where the wind carries them away.) Can you match the pictures to the method of dispersal?

Choking child What to do 1. 'Are you choking?' 2. Up to five back blows 3. Up to five abdominal thrusts 4. 999/112 if unsuccessful 5. Repeat steps two and three until help arrives

6. If casualty becomes unresponsive be prepared to begin CPR


