Science Spat

Exciting learning in Y5: This term Y5 have been learning about life cycles, and watching closely one of the most exciting verv transformations. Paige explained: In Mrs Reynolds' classroom we will soon have butterflies. They are in there because Year 5 are learning about life cycles of living things. We are looking at the stages of a butterfly. When we first got them they were small caterpillars in a container - they had food to eat. Over the course of a week, they had grown huge and at the weekend there were not caterpillars there but an amazing surprise...They were cocoons dangling from the top of the container. Four dangling from the top of the lid and one cocoon was not sticky, so it fell, but it is still going to hopefully live. In about a week there should be butterflies in our classroom.

Did you know? Caterpillars, while in their cocoons, turn to a liquid and the liquid reforms into a butterfly?
