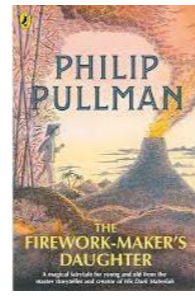
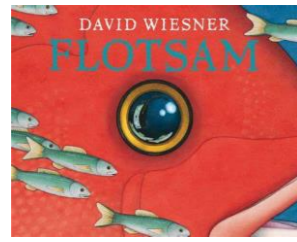


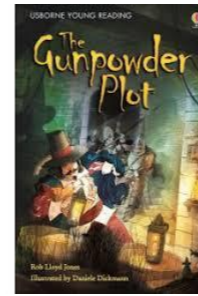
## Talk for Reading

Upon each gazing eye.



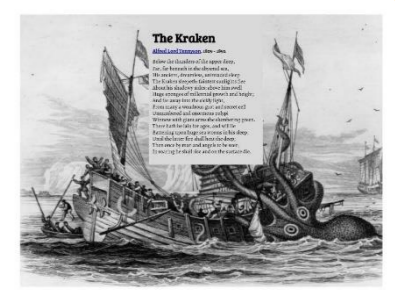
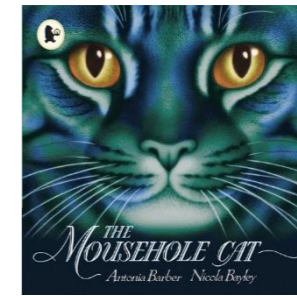
