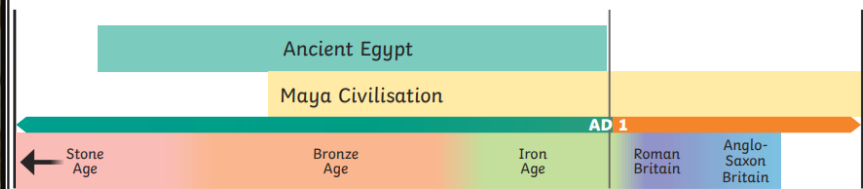

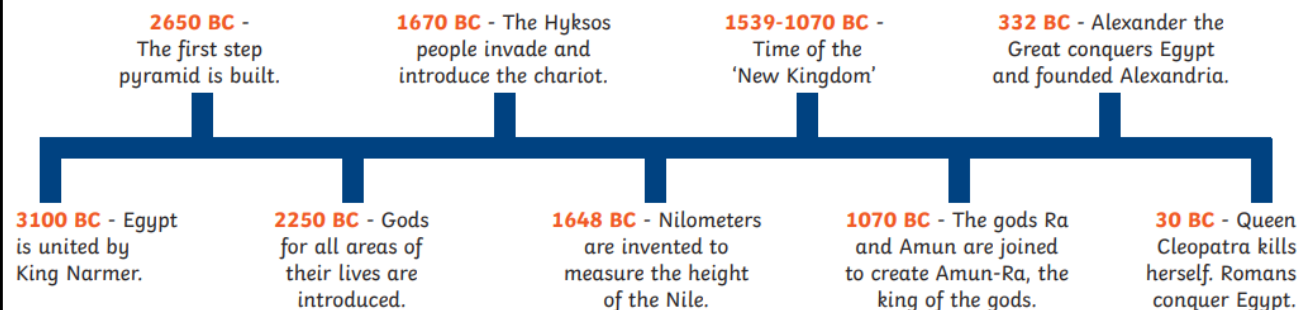
The Ancient Egyptian Empire

In 3000 BC, King Menes (Narmer) united two Egyptian kingdoms to build the empire of Ancient Egypt. It lasted over 3000 years until 30BC when the Romans took over.

Key Vocabulary

ancient	Something from a very long time ago.
civilisation	A human society with well-developed rules and government, often where technology and the arts are considered important
hieroglyphics	A system of writing that consists of pictures and symbols (hieroglyphs) instead of letters
the Nile	A river that runs through Egypt. It was essential to life in Ancient Egypt.
pharaoh	A ruler of Ancient Egypt.
tomb	A sealed room where a person was placed after death.
