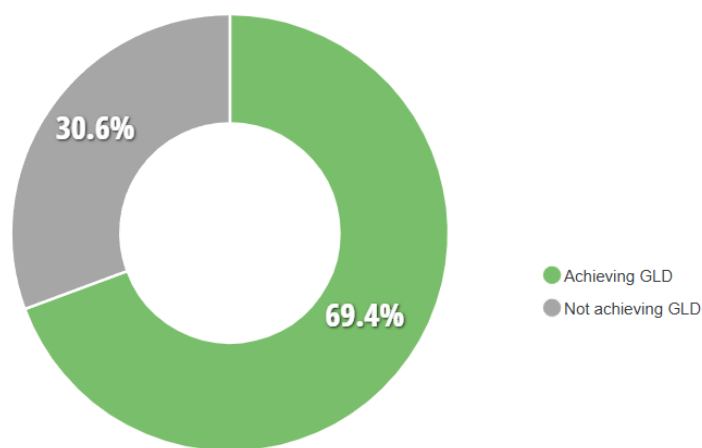


William Alvey School Data Overview 2024- 2025

Early Years Good Level of Development (GLD)

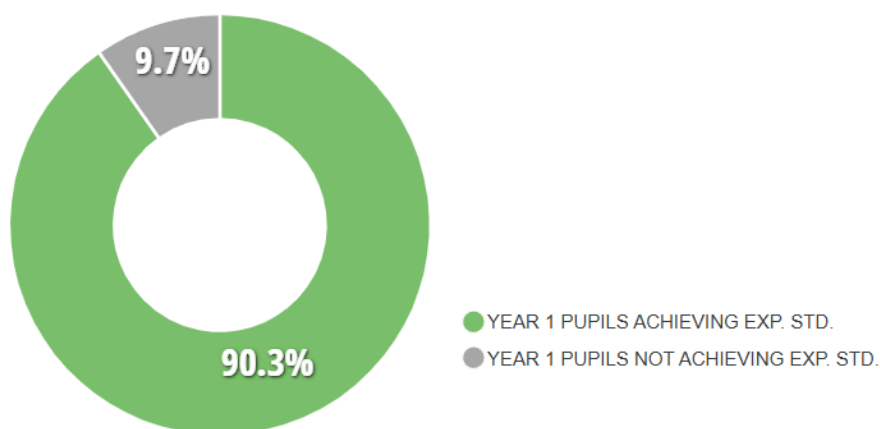
EYFSP: Good Level of Development | Value



- 69.4% achieved a Good Level of Development (GLD), a total of 43 pupils.
- This is above the national average of 68.3% and the local average of 66.4%.
- This is above the national average by the equivalent of 1 child.
- We are in the 51st percentile rank when compared to all schools nationally.

Year 1 Phonics

Phonics: Expected Standard (Year 1) | Value



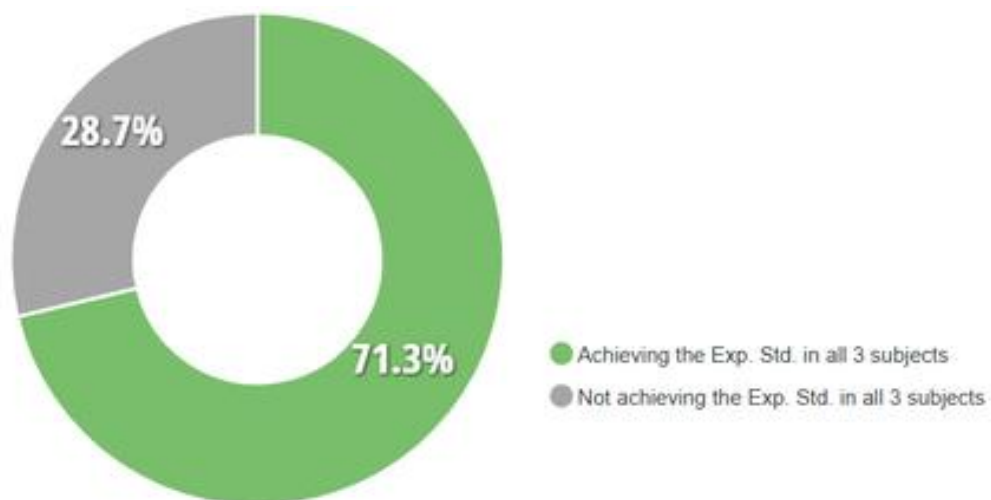
- From the Y1 phonics cohort of 72 pupils, 90.3% achieved the expected standard of 32 - a total of 65 pupils.
- The average point score of these pupils is 35.1.
- This is above the national average of 79.9% by 10.4%. This is the equivalent of 7 more pupils achieving the expected standard than the national average.
- When compared with all schools nationally, we are in percentile rank 19.

Y4 Multiplication Check

- 93 pupils took the MTC.
- 57% achieved 25/25 in their MTC test. The national average was 34% in 2024.
- Their average score was 22.7. The national average was 20.6 in 2024.
- 84% of our pupils scored over 20/25 on the MTC - this is equivalent to 78 pupils.

Key Stage Two

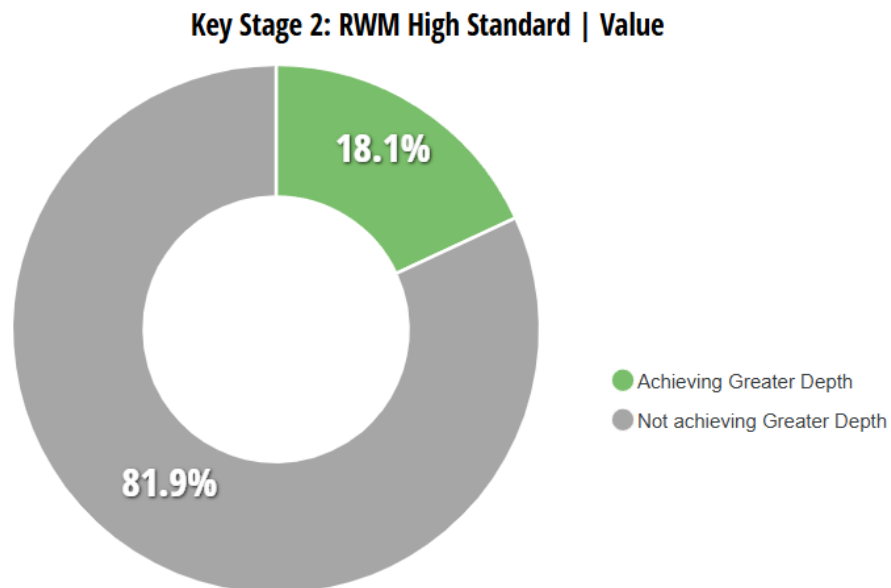
RWM expected standard



- Out of 94 Y6 pupils, 71.3% achieved the EXS standard in all three subjects of reading, writing and maths, a total of 67 pupils.
- This is 9.3% higher than the national average of 62%.

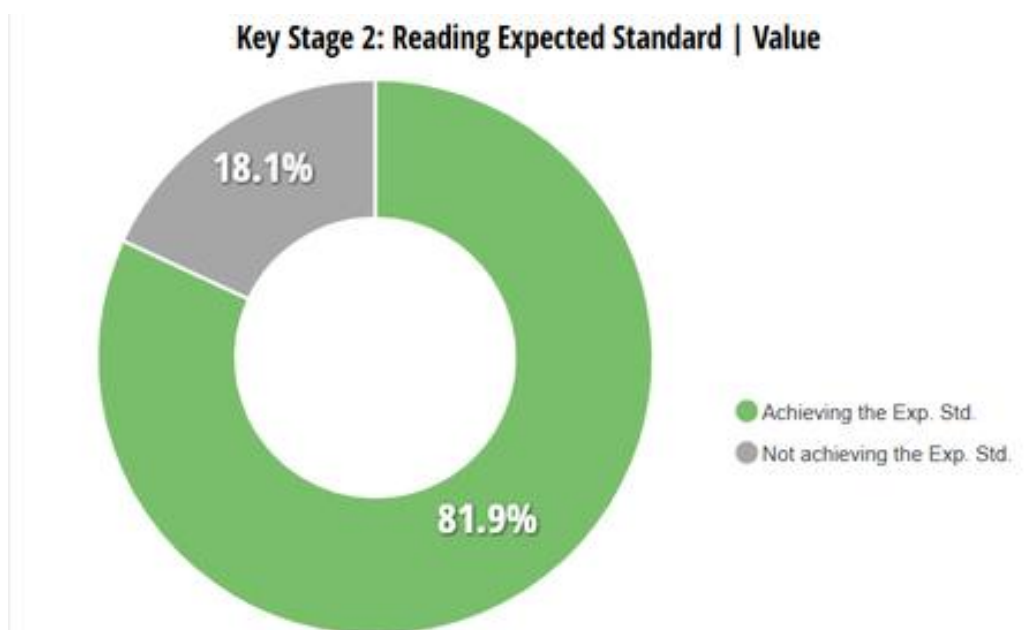
- This puts us in 31st percentile when compared to all schools nationally.

RWM Higher standard (Greater Depth)



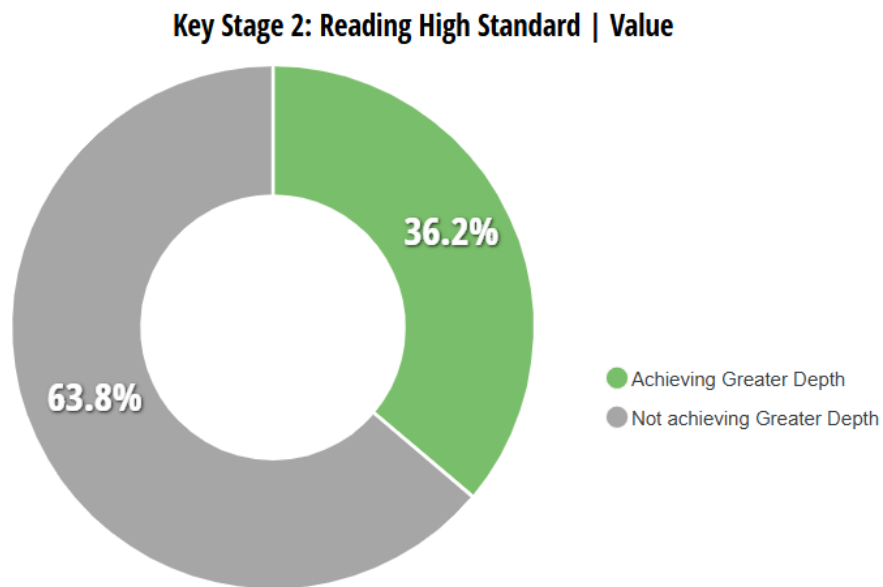
- 18.1% achieved the higher standard of Greater Depth in RWM, a total of 17 pupils. This is 10% higher than the national average of 8.1% which is the equivalent of 9 more pupils achieving the higher standard than the national average.
- This means we are in the 11th percentile when compared to schools nationally.

KS2 Reading



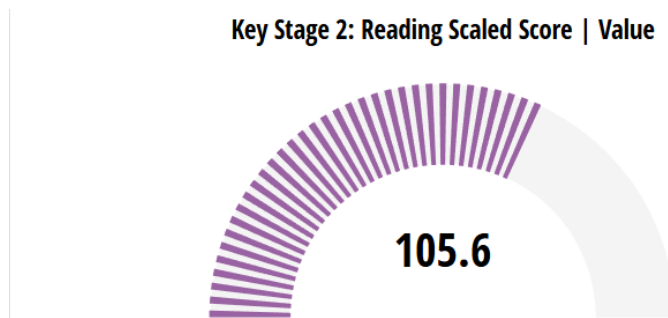
- Out of 94 pupils, 81.9% met the expected standard of reading at the end of KS2 - a total of 76 pupils.
- This is 7.1% higher than the national average which was 74.8%.
- Approximately 6 more pupils achieved the expected standard than the national average.
- This puts us in the 37th percentile for reading.

Key Stage 2 reading higher standard (Greater Depth)



- 36.2% of our pupils achieved the higher standard (greater depth) in reading. This is a total of 34 pupils.
- This is 3.3% higher than the national average of 32.9% which is the equivalent of 3 more pupils achieving the higher standard.
- The school is in percentile 40 when compared to all schools nationally for a higher standard in reading.

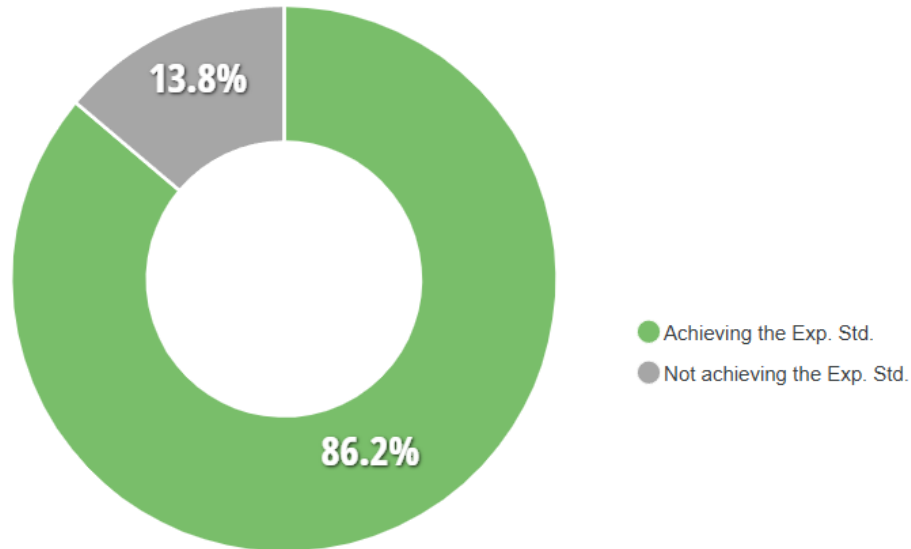
Key Stage 2 reading scaled score



- Our school has an average scaled score of 105.6 in reading based on a cohort of 94 pupils at the end of Key Stage 2.

Key Stage 2 Writing

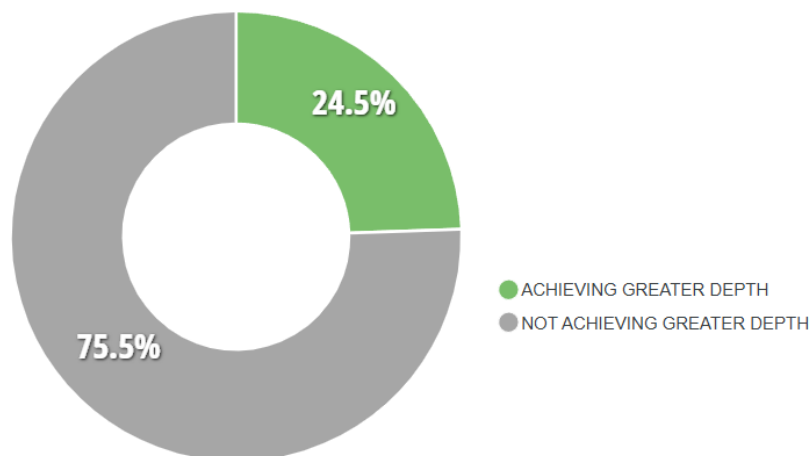
Key Stage 2: Writing Expected Standard | Value



- 86.2% of pupils achieved the expected standard in writing, a total of 81 pupils.
- The school's percentage is 14.3% higher than the national average of 71.9% which is the equivalent of 13 more pupils achieving the expected standard than the national average.
- The school is in the 13th percentile rank when compared to all schools nationally.
- The school's gap to the overall national outcome is +13.8%.

Key stage 2 writing at the higher standard (greater depth)

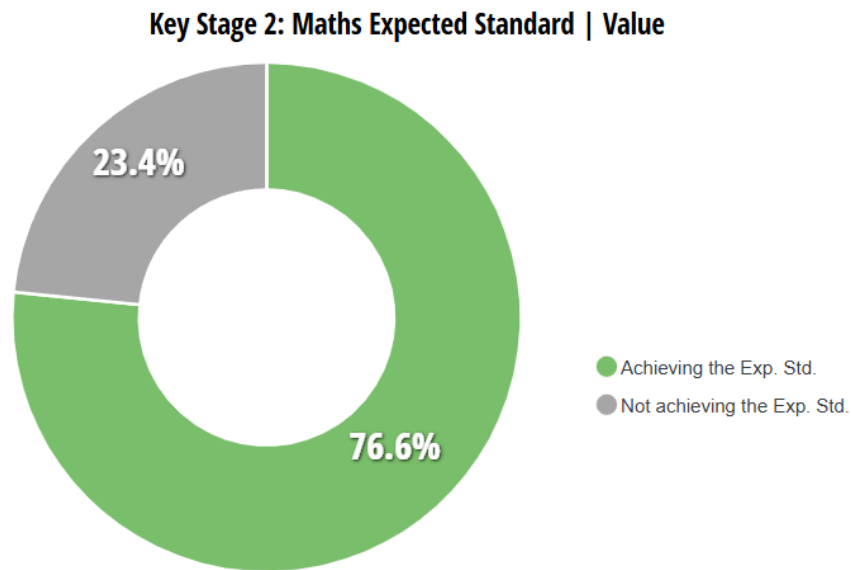
Key Stage 2: Writing Greater Depth | Value



- 23 out of 94 pupils achieved the higher standard in writing - 24.5%.

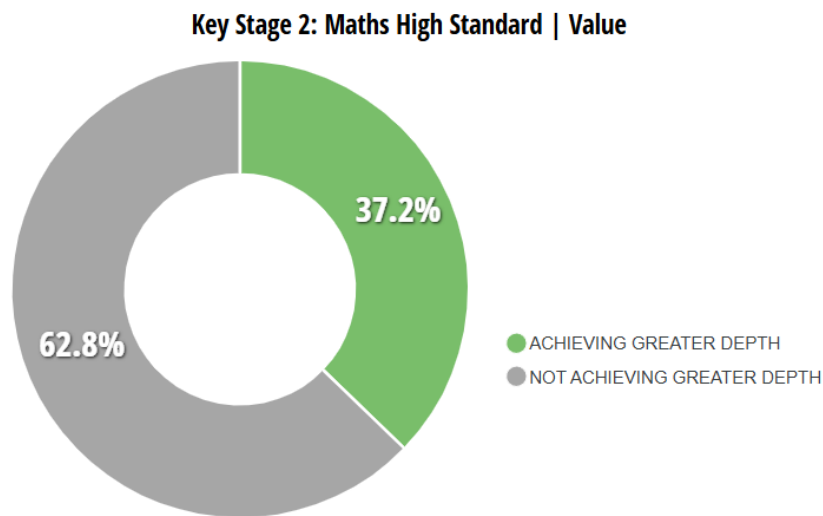
- This is 12% higher than the national average of 12.5%.
- This is equivalent to 11 more pupils achieving the higher standard than the national average.
- The school is in percentile rank 14 when compared to all schools nationally.

Key Stage 2 Maths



- 76.6% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in maths - a total of 72 pupils.
- The national average of pupils achieving the expected standard in maths is 74% therefore our school achieved 2.6% higher than the national average which is the equivalent to 2 pupils.
- Our school is in percentile 50 for our achievement in maths when ranked against all schools nationally.

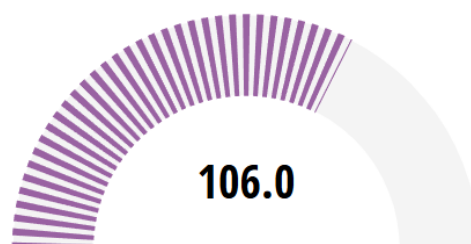
Key Stage 2 maths higher standard (greater depth)



- 37.2% of our pupils achieved the higher standard (greater depth) in maths. This is a total of 35 pupils.
- Our pupils achieved 11.2% higher than the national average of 26% which is the equivalent of 11 more pupils in our school achieving the higher standard in maths than the national average.
- Our school is in percentile 20 when compared to all schools nationally for pupils achieving the higher standard in maths.

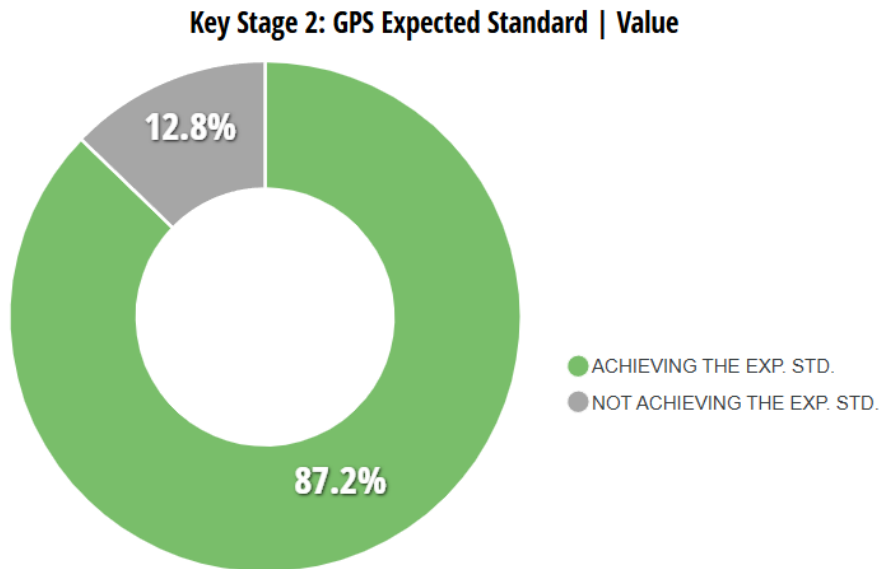
Key Stage 2 maths: Scaled score

Key Stage 2: Maths Scaled Score | Value



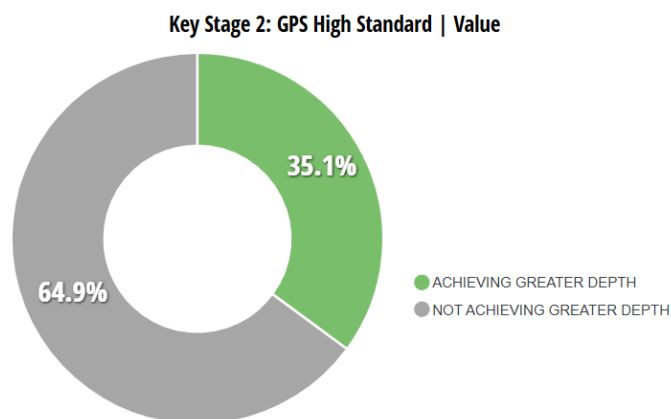
- This school has an average scaled score of 106.0 in maths based on a cohort of 94 pupils at the end of Key Stage 2.

- Key stage 2 Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling.



- 87.2% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in GPS - a total of 82 pupils.
- This is 14.9% higher than the national average of 73.2%. This is the equivalent of 14 more pupils achieving the expected standard than the national average.
- Our school is in percentile 16 when compared to all schools nationally for Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling.

Key Stage 2 Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling: Higher standard (Greater depth)



- 35.1% of our pupils achieved the higher standard in GPS (greater depth) which is a total of 33 pupils.
- This is 6% higher than the national average of 29.1% - the equivalent of 6 more pupils achieving the higher standard than the national average.

- Our school is ranked in percentile 31 when compared to all schools nationally.
