

Admission Appendix to add to the William Alvey Primary School's Admission policy

Should there be an over subscription issue for the Nursery, we will use the admission criteria set out in the whole school Admissions Policy.

As a setting registered to accept government funding, we offer free places for 3 and 4-year-olds for early learning sessions, subject to availability. These places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. There are a variety of 'start' options, which can be discussed with school staff as part of the admissions procedure.

The numbers and ages of children admitted to the nursery comply with the legal space requirements set out in the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS). When considering admissions, we are mindful of staff: child ratios and the facilities available at the Alvey Nursery.

We operate an equality policy and ensure that all children have access to our Nursery, irrespective of their gender, race, disability, religion or belief or sexual orientation of parents.

All funded sessions are offered in line with the relevant funding regulations as specified by the government. When you register your child for their Nursery place, we will discuss your needs and, meet them as best we can.

Prior to a child attending the Alvey Nursery, parents must complete and sign relevant paperwork issued by the school.

Please note that the Alvey Nursery will be closed during school holidays.
