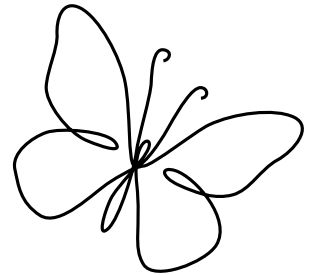

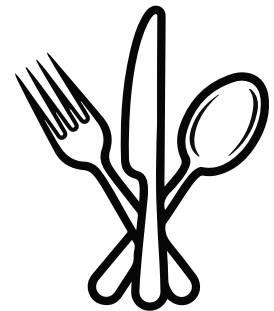
WEEK 1 - 10.09.26

Please complete the Word Class colouring sheet. Colour the verbs (action words) in yellow and the nouns (name of something) in blue.



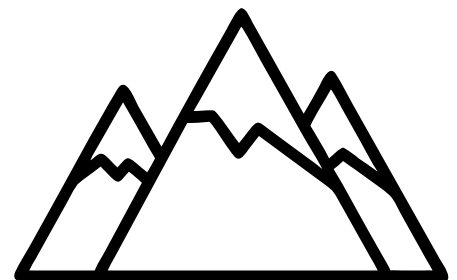
WEEK 2 - 17.09.26

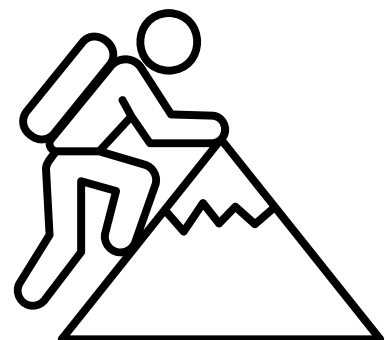
WEEK 3 - 24.09.26
